2. It's important to us that you involve your community in the design, development and delivery of the activities you're planning, so please tell us how you've done this.

Currently, we run weekly youth activities that engage with young people aged from 11 to 18 years old. Weekly we see young people from disadvantaged backgrounds most of them living in families that are marginalised and excluded. One of the problems we have identified running the project is that when the teenagers turn 18 years old they go to the streets as they fall out of our current bracket for youth work. There is no provision in our locality to work with young adults aged 18 to 25 years old and what is even worse is that the young adults who don't go to university, don't have jobs and become a negative influence on other young people as they hang around the streets and engage in deviant behaviour. This project has been birthed out of a desire to bridge the gap.

There is an increasing need for the most vulnerable young adults within our community. There is no provision for young adults who want to consider alternatives like enterprise development and the young adults that turn 18 years old are the ones who are no longer in college, didn't go to university or desire to do so, don't have work and are now hanging outside in the local estates engaging with other young people who are engaging in criminal activities (drugs, gangs and crime). They are unable to access services as they are too old. Often these young people struggle with their identity, sense of purpose and aspirations.

We are seeking funding to set up a 40 week Youth Enterprise Hub for young adults aged 18 to 25 years who are NEET and are finding it difficult to get jobs because of lack of aspirations, qualifications and because of the lack of local job availability. Delivering face to face sessions to young adults training them and setting up a Youth Enterprise Hub supporting young people to develop and implement business ideas in their local area. The workshops will be practical in nature and will allow these young adults to explore business ideas, researching them and running pilots.

Young adults will be trained and supported to develop and write their business idea. Allowing them to prepare themselves if they are looking for resources to develop their business ideas. Throughout the programme, young adults will be able to hear inspiring stories of others who have successfully set up their own businesses in the local area as well as those who have been working successfully self-employed. This project will be a lifeline to the youth in our local community who no longer think it is possible to get out of the cycle of unemployment and who as a result find themselves disconnected and marginalised. The project will enable more young people who are disadvantaged to fulfil their full potential by gaining the skills necessary to get into self-employment, employment or further education and development. Young people have voiced their needs of having the skills and support to get work and the project has been created to respond to that need and demand.
